Please encourage your students to submit their registrations promptly. All tickets must be paid for in advance, and tickets may not be purchased at the door. In the event that we exceed capacity, reservations will be honored in the order in which they are received. If a school's registration is unusually large, we may have to limit the number to accommodate other schools. You will be notified by phone if the size of your group needs to be adjusted.

In order to seat you, your students and their families together, we request that the students return their forms and checks (**payable to *The Philadelphia Classical Society***) directly to you. Please then mail these checks and forms as soon as possible, but please no later than **Thursday, April 9, 2009**. Enclosed is a form for your registration along with separate reproducible forms for your students. We have noted an earlier due date on the student form (**Tuesday, April 7**) in order to facilitate timely returns. On the teacher's registration form, please note the total number of chicken and vegetarian meals your students and families have ordered. Drexelbrook will not make last-minute changes to a school's order.

On the judging day, as has been our custom, certain projects from each category were identified by the judges as "Best of Category". We would like you to bring any of these projects for display at the luncheon. **Please make sure to bring these to Drexelbrook an hour early (by 11 a.m.)**. Teachers are also requested to see to the removal of all projects at the end of the luncheon.
